The successful candidate will support students with special needs to ensure that they integrate as fully as possible into the activities undertaken by the other students in school.

Essential Functions

- Assess student's abilities and find engaging activities to teach
- Adapt learning materials to student's needs
- Monitor student's behavioral patterns and initiate appropriate interventions
- Keep parents informed about their child's performance progress
- Designing and delivering the school's SEN strategy
- Work with fellow teaching staff to help identify students with learning needs
- Collect and interpret CAT4 and performance data and share as appropriate
- Provide guidance, and training to teachers to support students with SEN needs
- Carry out assessments of students with SEN to identify current needs and monitor progress - including observations in the classroom and meeting with teachers and parents
- Support teachers to develop learning programs for students with SEN
- Manage and advise the school on budget and resources for SEN provision
- Keep up to date with national and local policies related to SEN and cascade information to colleagues.
- Run specific programs and activities to assist the student's individual learning and social needs

Desired qualities and qualifications

- Bachelor's degree- Special Needs Education
- At least 2 years of experience working with children with special educational needs in an international school setting
- Trained in aspects of SEN
- Ability to communicate effectively with students with different abilities and ethnic backgrounds
- Ability to understand the particular needs of each student and provide modified materials as required



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- Aid access to the full range of learning experiences both inside and outside the classroom

The candidate must be able to:

- Demonstrate empathy and emotional intelligence, for recognizing and responding sensitively to the needs of students and parents
- Have patience with students who find conforming to rules and expectations difficult
- Maintain accurate records of the students
- Respect and maintain confidentiality but have regard to the safeguarding protocols of information sharing where necessary.
